



On the Rosenborgs road there is a big rock, approx 3 meters high and 2 meters wide. On the rock you will find the text "ROSENBERG TILL PARIS 1574 km".

The text was made on 1960s on the initiative of Cavalry Captain, Carl Johan Ekströmer inscribed the name Rosenberg.

Rosenborg was a cottage that lay a few hundred meters east of the stone. It was inhabited in the 30th century and was used once upon a time by a barn foreman at Klavreströms mill named Ros.

Road description to the rock: Mainroad 31 between Norrhult – Lindshammar. You turn off against Bränderydsvägen and continue 1 km on Bränderydsvägen and then turn of agains 300 years old tree on Rosenborgsvägen. Right before 300 years old tree you find the rock at your right hand side.
